WHO WE ARE

The Memphis Botanic Garden internship program is designed to provide an intensive, hands-on experience in a public garden for people studying and/or considering horticulture, botany, ecology, environmental studies, and biology as a career path.

WHAT WE DO

Our 96-acre campus includes 30 specialty gardens, an arboretum that is an Urban Forestry Center of Excellence for the state of Tennessee and holds a Level IV status from TUFC and a Level II accreditation from Arbnet, propagation and greenhouses, educational programs, and more!

PROGRAM FEATURES

Each Intern will be assigned a focus area where they will spend a majority of their time. In addition to your focus area, each week will feature a mentoring session with a member of MBG's Horticulture staff:

- Week 1: Native plants and Ecological Landscape Practices/ Forest Ecosystems
- Week 2: Irrigation and Pest Management
- Week 3: Pruning Techniques/ Japanese Garden Aesthetics

Week 4: Herbs

- Week 5: Pollinator Plants and Butterflies
- Week 6: Rose and Hydrangea Care
- Week 7: Tree Care and Arboriculture
- Week 8: Organic Vegetable Growing and Orchard
- Week 9: Greenhouse Management and Plant Propagation (how to take soft cuttings)
- Week 10: Botanical Field Trip
