LIVE AT THE GARDEN ANNOUNCES 2023 CONCERT LINEUP

Memphis, TN, April 19, 2023 – Memphis Botanic Garden (MBG) is proud to announce the lineup for this year’s annual Live at the Garden concert series, presented by Regions Bank, taking place in the Radians Amphitheater. The series will kick off June 3 with country vocal trio **Lady A**, followed by 90s rock band **Matchbox Twenty** on June 24, Academy of Country Music's reigning Duo of the Year **Brothers Osborne** on July 14, classic rock superstars The **Doobie Brothers with Michael McDonald** on August 25, and American pop-rock band **Train** on September 8.
