

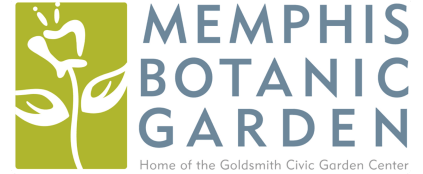

Dogs are welcome during these special extended hours, and a cash bar will be available to grab a seasonal sip, beer, or wine to enjoy during their visit.

The second Thursday of each month will feature food trucks & live music including Jeremy Stanfill and Josh Cosby, Tracking Giants, Short in the Sleeve, Rowdy Franks, and Movie Night Band. Memphis food truck favorites will be on-site May 11, June 8, July 13, August 10, September 14, and October 12 for a picnic dinner.
