

## SUPPLY LIST FOR ACRYLIC PAINTING CLASS

If you are a beginner and have some paints feel free to bring what you have. This is a *recommended list*, but we can be flexible.

### PAINT

I use mostly Liquitex professional acrylics heavy body. Student grade is cheaper but far less quality. Watch for sales and coupons at Michaels and Hobby Lobby

Reds- cadmium red light, naphthol Crimson, quinacridone crimson

Blues- ultra marine, phthalocyanine blue,

Yellows- lemon or light yellow, yellow oxide or yellow ochre Burnt sienna and raw umber

Titanium white Ivory black

Greens- phthalocyanine green,

I also love dioxazine if you want a purple and sap green for another green and cerulean blue (you don't have to have every single color. )

### BRUSHES

Get an assortment of round and flat brushes size 0,4,8 that are recommended for acrylics A filbert brush is nice when painting clouds. You may buy a set of brushes .

Vines charcoal sticks for sketching on canvas Kneaded eraser Paint shirt or apron Can or cup for water Paper towels

Palette- styrofoam plates works well

### CANVAS

You can choose up to 16 -20 size

### OPTIONAL

Palette knife

Table Easel if desired (not necessary but some students find it helpful)
