## SUPPLY LIST FOR ACRYLIC PAINTING CLASS

If you are a beginner and have some paints feel free to bring what you have. This is a *recommended list*, but we can be flexible.

## <u>PAINT</u>

I use mostly Liquitex professional acrylics heavy body. Student grade is cheaper but far less quality. Watch for sales and coupons at Michaels and Hobby Lobby

Reds- cadmium red light, napthol Crimson, quinqcridone crimson Blues- ultra marine, phthalocyanine blue, Yellows- lemon or light yellow, yellow oxide or yellow ochre Burnt sienna and raw umber Titanium white lvory black Greens- phthalocyanine green,

I also love dioxazine if you want a purple and sap green for another green and cerulean blue (you don't have to have every single color.)

## BRUSHES

Get an assortment of round and flat brushes size 0,4,8 that are recommended for acrylics A filbert brush is nice when painting clouds. You may buy a set of brushes .

Vines charcoal sticks for sketching on canvas Kneaded eraser Paint shirt or apron Can or cup for water Paper towels Palette- styrofoam plates works well

<u>CANVAS</u> You can choose up to 16 -20 size

<u>OPTIONAL</u> Palette knife Table Easel if desired (not necessary but some students find it helpful) If you have questions feel free to call Gay Rhodes at 901-849-6346
